Sunday—June 9, 2024

Registration pick-up at the hotel. There will be a short tour late Sunday to our picnic dinner buffet opening at Olde Village Mill. Roundtrip of 10 miles including our first covered bridge of the week. If daylight is a concern, you can drive modern or grab a backseat that evening.

Monday—June 10, 2024

The tour will kick off with a jaunt through some hill and dale to a coffee stop at the upholstery shop of Daniel Petersheim. From Daniel's shop we will travel up to The Landis Valley Farm Museum for a boxed lunch and private tour of their facilities. On the way home we will stop at the amazing collection of Jim Keener and Rob Shingle for an Ice Cream stop and to see their amazing collection and garages. Once our stomachs are full we will head back to the hotel. Dinner on your own. Estimated mileage for the day ~ 75 Miles.

Tuesday—June 11, 2024

This morning stock up on some coffee at the hotel or stop in the town of Strasburg for coffee for a long day of touring. We will be heading southwest meeting up with the Susquehanna River. We will follow the river north to the town of Columbia where you can spend sometime in the numerous antique shops, National Watch and Clock Museum, Turkey Hill Experience, etc. We will head over the Susquehanna River to the John Wright Restaurant (buffet style) for lunch then over and around the hills of York, Pennsylvania to the home of Susquehanna Region of the HCCA members' house of David and Nel Deardorff. The Deardorff's will host our Ice Cream stop for the day and allow us all to tour their incredible collection of hit or miss and stationary engines large and small. From the Deardorff's we will head back to the hotel through

several covered bridges. Dinner on your own. Estimated milage for the day ~90 miles.

Wednesday—June 12, 2024

This mornings coffee stop will be at Paul B's Hardware store in Lititz, PA. Any and all fasteners or fittings can be found in this hardware store, so come with a shopping list. From Paul B's we will be heading over to tour the Ephrata Cloisters. Our lunch will be served at the Pour Man Brewing Company (choice chosen below) in Ephrata. The Ice Cream stop options will be a new ice cream shop in Ephrata or Fox Meadows Creamery about 12 miles from lunch (either one would be on your own) with an optional stop at the Mascot Roller Mills and Ressler Family Home Museum. We will be having our closing gathering tonight so tour participants can depart tomorrow after returning to the hotel. Estimated milage for the day ~65 miles.

Thursday—June 13, 2024

For some excitement for our last day of touring, we will be heading to Fishing Creek Road after a coffee stop at the Robert Fulton Birthplace Historical Museum. Fishing Creek Road is a winding road the intertwines with the Fishing Creek. There are 3 cement basin creek fordings along the road. For those tour participants that do not wish to ford a creek 3 times with their brass era car, there will be a by pass in the directions. From Fishing Creek Road we will be heading to Britain Hill Winery for a buffet style lunch. On the way home we will pass through a few covered bridges and have our final Ice Cream Stop at the Down At The Farm Creamery (on your own) on the way back to the hotel. Estimated milage for the day ~60 Miles.
