Sunday—June 9, 2024

Registration pick-up at the hotel. There will be a short tour late Sunday to our picnic dinner buffet opening at Olde Village Mill. Roundtrip of 10 miles including our first covered bridge of the week. If daylight is a concern, you can drive modern or grab a backseat that evening.

Monday—June 10, 2024

The tour will kick off with a jaunt through some hill and dale to a coffee stop at the upholstery shop of Daniel Petersheim. From Daniel's shop we will travel up to The Landis Valley Farm Museum for a boxed lunch and private tour of their facilities. On the way home we will stop at the amazing collection of Jim Keener and Rob Shingle for an Ice Cream stop and to see their amazing collection and garages. Once our stomachs are full we will head back to the hotel. Dinner on your own. Estimated milage for the day ~ 75 Miles.
