Old Business

• Regional Group-Premiere Events

Jim spoke about HCCA recruitment opportunities at premiere car events. Jim and Kim are the committee that was formed to research the idea of HCCA sponsorship of regional groups at future premier car events. They referenced the Rolex Monterey Motorsports Reunion that attracts 90,000 spectators each year at this single event of many events during Monterey Car Week.

Kim brought up for Board discussion:

- BOD engagement
- Premiere car events where we could help regional groups recruit new HCCA members
 - Monterey Car Week
 - Amelia Island
 - Detroit Old Car Festival
- What might National club provide to the regional group hosting:
 - National advertising
 - HCCA Banners
 - Merchandise (hats, etc.)
 - Funding (\$ TBD) to pay for first time memberships
 - National applications
 - Rack cards and referral to regional group where interested individuals live
 - New section on trifold that can be detached with prospects' names
 - Talking points to engage passers-by. Don't only talk to one another; start a new conversation
 - Carbide generators are for
 - Crank start
 - Acetylene gas is created
 - Kerosene is used....
 - The Model T has THREE pedals because...

Mike mentioned that Haggerty Insurance is assuming ownership/sponsorship responsibilities at several premiere car events and may be a good contact for the committee. Jim said he would look into Haggerty and get back to the Board.

• Website

Peter Garipey is requesting to have the hcca.org website maintain the database of members to download and also load the changes daily. The new database that Peter is providing to the club is for office informational use. Peter's new database will replace to old database which will be easier to update and utilize. HCCA's forum page has been added to AACA's forum and labelled Horseless Carriage Club of America.

Jim spoke about and inquired into the original calendar project: In July, 2022, the HCCA Board of Directors approved the development and implementation of an expanded hcca.org calendar that would include five icons at the top of the calendar page; Western Regions, Central Regions, Eastern Regions, National and International. The idea for this was based on better regional and national coordination of tours and events therefore minimizing conflicting dates. Each regional group main point of contact would be provided an access code and be responsible for their own groups sub-calendar to add, delete and edit tour and event information. The former webmaster

provided the initial setup in December, 2022. The concept worked but needed extensive development to become operational. The HCCA website committee should continue with the new webmaster to see to the implementation of this project. Jim added that his last “Club Comments” in the Gazette were about the new and coming soon hcca.org calendar, and that two regional groups called him over the weekend inquiring about the reported updated calendar.

Russell added that the website committee work a great deal on the hcca.org calendar project with the former webmaster. However, with the new webmaster, there have been many items that needed initial attention and asked Jim to join the website committee to assist seeing the updated calendar project through to implementation. Russell said there has been a lot of telephone and email conversations back and forth with Peter, over the last four weeks, regarding a website issue that has since been resolved. The website committee has recently worked with Peter on:

- website updates
- calendar updates
- boards members listed in correct order
- educational updates
- adding/deleting vehicles, now is much better but not with year of make searches

- **Activities**

Mike said that HCCA’s involvement at Hershey is in his name and a new point of contact needs to be established. Vince stated that he is ready and willing to take on as primary with HCCA’s 2024 involvement at Hershey; Kim said that she will assist Vince as both worked well together in 2023.

- **Strategic Planning**

Andy was prepared to speak about the Marion Welsh and the Art Twohy awards at this time but was referred to speak about this under New Business. Andy stated that there have been nomination(s) for both awards and the results will be tallied in the next few days.

- **Quebec, Canada Representative**

Following the November 20, 2023 Board discussion, the Quebec, Canada representative, Andre De Montigny has been added to the hcca.org website. He currently has fifteen members and will soon seek official Board approval for Quebec Regional Group status.

- **Member Voting**

Brief discussion occurred regarding should members in good standing, “active members” who no longer own a horseless carriage, still be allowed voting privileges. This item was referred to the bi-laws committee, to be discussed further at the next Board meeting.

- **HCCA Crest**

Don reported that the HCCA crest from the Northern California Regional Group is currently being restored. Don said that, between Vince and he, the crest will be picked up this year and moved to a desirable location.

- **Member Advertising on Website**

Mike is looking to form a new committee that will investigate the discussed information and concerns from HCCA club member, Ed Archer. This was previously discussed by the Board of Directors at the November 20, 2023 meeting and needs to continue with follow-up.

The Board of Directors' meeting is March 15, 11:00AM. The general membership meeting is March 20, 4:00PM just prior to the 6:00PM final banquet. Russell requested as many Board members to be present in person for this National HCCA event.

Russell spoke about the 2024 Tweed Valley International Tour saying it is coming together nicely and he has locked in a welcoming function for participants. Russell has a date night/mingle event planned for participants to get to know each other and has a photo of his Maytag "Watch for Koalas."

- **Hershey**

Kim and Vince spoke about the supply of HCCA merchandise is currently sufficient. Additional conversation from the Board about the need for the tri-fold information to get to all regional groups. Mike will contact Lindsey to have 25 tri-folds sent to each regional group POC.

Strategic Planning

Mike and Andy spoke about the need for a thorough understanding of the nomination requirements for the Marian Welsh Award and the Art Twohy Award. Andy has received nominations for both and reminded the Board members who have not yet voted to please do so asap. There is only one nomination for the Art Twohy Award as Jim withdrew his nomination for an entire regional group for this award. Andy proposed that the Board should consider creating an award of recognition of a regional group that has done exceptional work in the areas of recruitment, public education on the history of the automobile, and automotive restoration and preservation. This was moved for more discussion at the next Board meeting. Doug to take the lead with Mike and Peter to assist.

HCCA Gazette Editor

Mike stated that he has updated the editor contract changing only the start date being the January/February 2024 issue of the HCCA Gazette (moved to calendar year) running throughout 2024 with six published issues.
