## **Some highlights of this year's Hershey Hangover XV Tour:**

### **Friday, October 9 – Arrive at Hotel after Hershey Show – No Organized Touring Planned**

Registration Pick-Up opens at 3 PM and 6:30 PM Meet and Greet Buffet with Cash Bar at Hotel

### **Saturday, October 10**

Morning of touring into Chester County with a morning stop (coffee and donuts as well) at the National Iron and Steel Museum in Coatesville for a tour. After our visit to the museum, we will pass through more of beautiful Chester County in route to Stargazer Winery. Lunch will be on your own, and we have identified three potential lunch stops (like last year), all with unique character and offerings. From the winery, we will head north while passing an excellent ice cream stop! Dinner on Saturday evening is on your own. 75 miles of driving.

### **Sunday, October 11**

We are headed north-west into Lancaster and Lebanon Counties to a coffee stop and shopping in Adamstown at Renninger's Antique Market. From there we will travel to historic Schaefferstown for a buffet lunch. Our afternoon will be more scenic roads and a tour of the Historic Cornwall Iron Furnace. From Cornwall, we will head back towards Morgantown with an ice cream stop in Reinholds. Our Closing Banquet will be at the hotel in the large ballroom with our annual Pinewood Derby following dinner as a Fund Raiser for the Museum of the Horseless Carriage. Bring your BSA approved racers for a fun evening event. Prizes will be awarded! The hotel bar will also be open! Total mileage of 80 miles.

### **Monday, October 12**

Leisurely morning drive through Amish farmland to a coffee stop and visit at Holland Coach in New Holland. From there we will travel to our buffet lunch at Yoder's in New Holland! No ice cream stop on the way back to the hotel on this shorter tour day. Total mileage of 60 miles.

I have spoken to Classic Auto Mall and they will be open Monday afternoon for anyone wanting to take a look at their vehicles.

**Tour will be limited to 50 cars.**

Parking for trailers and rigs will be at the hotel.

No hook-ups for motorhomes.

Hotel Reservation includes daily hot breakfast – 2 per each room.

Registration fee will include Friday evening meet/greet at the hotel, Saturday's coffee stop, admission to the Iron and Steel Museum. Saturday lunch and evening dinner will be on your own. Sunday includes coffee stop, buffet lunch, admission to Cornwall Furnace and banquet at the hotel. Monday includes coffee stop and buffet lunch at Yoders.

Individual **Cancellations will be allowed with full refund until September 1, 2026** – prorated after that date. We will keep a waiting list and use to back fill any cancellations if possible.
