Lindsey commented about the changes in the database and email systems, and mentioned that she is still working off of two computers. She offered that she cannot get the old database to transfer to the new computer, and that she has been working with Peter Findlay to try and get things squared away. As part of this, the database syncing function is still not working automatically. Changes to the old profile do not get migrated automatically.

Lindsay offered that while the overall experience is that things are better for the membership, the back-end office work is still a bit of a challenge, and that she has been dealing with the fires.

Doug commented on the situation offering that Lindsey needs to have an easy database to work with and that she should receive help to move the old database to her new computer to make the work easier. Doug also offered some background history of the development of the database which went from the John Gephardt (Access Database) to Peter Findlay (Filemaker).

Don Plumb asked a question on whether the issue is related to hardware differences between the computers. Lindsey confirmed that it is a software issue.

Russell commented that he thought that Peter Findlay had already done this, Lindsey responded that Peter Findlay is doing his best, but there are still issues.

In line with Russell's comments, Doug offered that this needs to become a board focus.

In addition, Lindsey brought up that the club is not charging credit card processing fees, and that we pay a lot in fees. Russell directed Lindsey to set up SWIPE to automatically process the transaction fee.

- Contractual arrangements for the HCCA Annual Tour and Convention submitted by Russell Holden:

Currently the duty of organising the HCCA Annual Tour and Convention has fallen to the Vice President, who has in the past, been required to personally guarantee the number of rooms blocked off at the lead hotel and the catering requirements, room hire and any other necessary contracts required for the successful running of the tour and convention. Historically, individuals have been forced to enter into contracts personally guaranteeing up to \$40,000 in funds and requested to sign all manner of contracts and provide personal guarantees for short falls, etc.

In organising the Annual Tour and Convention, the Vice President is organising the Club's National Tour and Convention, not their "personal" Tour & Convention. As such, the obligation for entering into contracts should be held by the Horseless Carriage Club of America at the National level, not the individual member tasked by the Club to organise the event.

This motion seeks to alleviate this responsibility of the individual and have the National Club take on this responsibility.

Recommendation:

1. That the Board provide approval on an annual basis for a selected HCCA member to organise the Annual Tour and Convention and negotiate contractual obligations with hotels and other necessary organizations, required for the running of the tour and convention, on behalf of the Horseless Carriage Club of America.
2. That prior to the signing of any contracts, that the Executive Board of the HCCA is provided with written copies of said contract or contracts, and will provide individual written delegated authority to the selected HCCA member to enter into said contract or contracts on behalf of the National Board.
3. The Board develop guidelines as to the requirements of the Tour and Convention for future organisers to follow.

In line with the documented items, a motion was made by Russell to nominate Jim Skillicorn to chair the 2026 National Convention and grant him authority to put the event on
